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An ordinance amending Subsections (a), (c) and (h) of Section 5.450 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code relative to changing the name of the City of Los Angeles Domestic Violence Task Force to the City of Los Angeles Domestic Violence Alliance

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The title of Chapter 64 of Division 5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:

PROSECUTION REGARDING CITY OF LOS ANGELES DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ALLIANCE TRUST FUND

- Sec. 2. Subsection (a) of Section 5.450 of Chapter 64, Division 5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:
- (a) There is hereby created and established in the Treasury of the City of Los Angeles a special trust fund to be known as the "Furtherance of Education, Prevention, Response and Prosecution Regarding City of Los Angeles Domestic Violence Alliance Trust Fund."
- Sec. 3. The second sentence in Subsection (c) of Section 5.450 of Chapter 64, Division 5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:
- (c) Expenditures from the Fund shall be authorized by the City of Los Angeles Domestic Violence Alliance.
- Sec. 4. Subsection (h) of Section 5.450 of Chapter 64, Division 5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:
- (h) The General Manager of the Housing + Community Investment
 Department, or his or her designee, shall prepare and transmit financial statements for
 the Fund to the Treasurer of the City of Los Angeles Domestic Violence Alliance, for
 and as of the end of each calendar quarter, within 60 days after the end of said quarter.

Sec. 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
