ORDINANCE NO.

An Ordinance of the City of Los Angeles changing the name of Berendo Street between Sunset Boulevard and Fountain Avenue and establishing the same as L. Ron Hubbard Way.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Los Angeles finds that the public interest, convenience and necessity require that the name of that certain public street, being the first street westerly of New Hampshire Street and lying between Sunset Boulevard and Fountain Avenue which, or any portion of which, may be or may have been named or known as or called Berendo Street be and the same is hereby changed to and established as L. Ron Hubbard Way.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 281 of the Charter of the City of Los Angeles, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication.
