CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION, COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE and RESOLUTION relative to a portion of an L-shaped alley easterly of McKinley Avenue and southerly of 42nd Street.

Recommendations for Council action:

- 1. FIND that this vacation is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 pursuant to Article VII, Class 5(3) of the City's Environmental Guidelines.
- 2. ADOPT the FINDINGS of the City Engineer dated September 10, 2002, as the Findings of Council.
- 3. ADOPT the City Engineer's report dated September 10, 2002, that subject to the conditions enumerated therein, vacation proceedings (VAC-E1400772) BE INSTITUTED for the vacation of the public right-of-way for a portion of the L-shaped alley adjacent to Lots 4 through 6, John Taylor Tract and Lots 20 through 22, Mettlers Central Avenue Tract, lying easterly of McKinley Avenue and southerly of 42nd Street.
- 4. ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION TO VACATE No. 02-1400772 for this vacation.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The City Engineer reports that as of May 13, 2002, an estimated \$1,649.87 in charges have been expended in the investigation and processing of this proceeding. Approximately \$1,300 will be required from the General Fund to complete these proceedings. Since Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC), Section 7.46, exempts all governmental agencies from payment of fees, the processing of this report will be absorbed by the Bureau of Engineering.

# SUMMARY

On November 13, 2002, the Chair of the Public Works Committee considered a report of the City Engineer relative to initiating vacation proceedings for a portion of an L-shaped alley easterly of McKinley Avenue and southerly of 42nd Street.



The petitioner, the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD), owner of the properties shown outlined in yellow on the map attached to the Council File, is requesting vacation of the public alley areas shown colored blue on said map. The petitioner plans to consolidate the vacation areas with its adjoining properties for an elementary school site. This vacation was approved by the City Planning Director on September 14, 2001. Pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code, Section 8334(b), this vacation can be processed under summary vacation proceedings since the areas lie within properties under one ownership and does not continue through such ownership or end touching the property of another.

Inasmuch as no opposition was expressed at the meeting, the Chair of the Public Works Committee concurred with the Department's recommendations without discussion and forwarded the matter to Council for its consideration.

# RESOLUTION TO VACATE NO. 02-1400772 (California Streets and Highways Code Section 8334(b))

Vacation of the L-shaped alley (portion of) easterly of McKinley Avenue and southerly of 42nd Street.

The Council of the City of Los Angeles hereby finds and determines that the portion of the L-shaped alley adjacent to Lots 4 through 6, John Taylor Tract and Lots 20 through 22, Mettlers Central Avenue Tract, lying easterly of McKinley Avenue and southerly of 42nd Street is unnecessary for present or prospective public alley purposes subject to the reservation and exception of a permanent easement for public utility purposes; and

That the vacation thereof will not cut off all access to any of the real properties adjoining said public alleys; and the public interest, convenience and necessity require the summary vacation of said public alleys pursuant to Section 8334(b) of the California Streets and Highways Code.

The City Council hereby elects to proceed under this provision of said Code Section; and hereby resolves that said public alleys be and the same are vacated; and

The particular portions of the public alleys which are to be vacated and said permanent easement and right for public utility facilities to be reserved therefrom are described herein as follows:

That certain portion of the L-shaped alley 20 feet and 12 feet wide as shown on the maps of John Taylor Tract and Mettlers Central Avenue Tract, recorded in Book 8, page 108 and in Book 6, page 196, both of Maps, respectively, in the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, adjoining Lots 4, 5 and 6, of said John Taylor Tract, and Lots 20, 21 and 22 of said Mettlers Central Avenue Tract, bounded northerly by a line parallel with and distant 7 feet southerly measured at right angles from the northerly line of said Lot 6, John Taylor Tract; and bounded easterly by the southerly prolongation of the westerly line of the easterly 20 feet of said Lot 20, Mettlers Central Avenue Tract.

RESERVING and EXCEPTING therefrom, an easement for public utility purposes for the use of Pacific Bell over the entire vacation areas described hereinabove.

The City Clerk shall certify this Resolution and affix the City seal, and shall transmit a sealed copy of this Resolution to the Land Development Group of the Bureau of Engineering for recordation in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, upon compliance with the conditions for the vacation.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED that from and after the recordation of this Resolution, the areas described hereinabove are vacated.

# CONDITIONS FOR STREET VACATION:

The Conditions specified in this report are established as the requirements to be complied with by the petitioner for this vacation. Vacation proceedings in which the conditions have not been completed within 180 days of the Council's action on the City Engineer's report, shall be terminated, with no further Council action.

- 1. That a 7-foot wide strip of land be dedicated as public street along the southerly side of 42nd Street easterly of the north-south alley to be vacated adjoining the petitioner's properties to complete a 32-foot wide half street dedication.
  - 2. That the petitioner dedicate a 20-foot wide replacement alley connecting 42nd Street to the westerly terminus of the offsite unvacated portion of the east-west alley.
  - 3. That the following improvements be constructed adjoining the petitioner's properties in a manner satisfactory to the City Engineer:
    - a) Construct a 20-foot and variable width replacement alley with standard alley improvements including a concrete longitudinal gutter along the centerline of the 20-foot wide replacement alley dedication.
    - b) Construct standard street improvements along the southerly side of 42nd Street to complete a 22-foot half roadway including a 10-foot wide concrete sidewalk, curb and gutter, a type II driveway from the alley being vacated to the existing improvements to the east.
    - c) Close off any unused driveways, repair any broken and/or offgrade sidewalk, curb and gutter and trim uprooting tree roots and reconstruct sidewalk to grade along the southerly side of 42nd Street.
    - d) Repair any broken and/or offgrade sidewalk, curb and gutter along the northerly side of 42nd Place.
    - e) Construct a handicapped access ramp at the southeast corner of McKinley Avenue and 42nd Street.

- f) Repair any broken and/or offgrade sidewalk, curb and gutter along the easterly side of McKinley Avenue.
- g) Construct a standard driveway apron or close off the alley being vacated at 42nd Street with standard street improvements including sidewalk, curb and gutter.
- 4. That arrangements be made with Pacific Bell for the removal of affected facilities or the providing of easements or rights for the protection of affected facilities to remain in place.
- 5. That street lighting facilities be installed as may be required by the Bureau of Street Lighting.
- 6. That street trees be planted and tree wells be installed as may be required by the Street Tree Division of the Bureau of Street Services.

## DISCUSSION:

<u>Request</u>: The petitioner, the Los Angeles Unified School District, owners of the properties shown outlined in yellow on Exhibit "A", is requesting the vacation of the public alley areas shown colored blue.

The petitioner plans to consolidate the vacation areas with their adjoining properties for an elementary school site.

<u>Resolution to Vacate</u>: The Resolution to Vacate will be recorded upon compliance with the conditions established for this vacation.

Zoning and Land Use: The properties adjoining the alleys being vacated to the north and to the south are zoned (Q)C2-1VL and (Q)R3-1, respectively and are presently vacant lots. The properties to the west are zoned M1-1VL and are also vacant lots.

<u>Description of Areas to be Vacated</u>: The areas sought to be vacated are the unimproved alleys (L-shaped) adjacent to Parcel A, Parcel Map L.A. No. 4240. The alleys being vacated are fenced off with chain-link fence.

Adjoining Street and Alley: 42nd Street is an improved local street dedicated 50 feet and 57 feet in width with a 34-foot wide roadway, curbs and sidewalks on both sides. McKinley Avenue is an improved local street dedicated 60 feet in width with a 40-foot wide roadway, curbs and sidewalks on both sides.

<u>Surrounding Properties</u>: The adjoining owners, Lots 19 and 26, Mettler's Central Avenue Tract, have been notified of the proposed street vacation.

<u>Effects of Vacation on Circulation and Access</u>: The vacation of the alleys should have no adverse effect on vehicular circulation or access, since the alleys are unimproved and fenced off on both ends.

The alleys are also not needed for the use of pedestrians, bicyclists or equestrians.

Objections to the Vacation: There were no written objections to the vacation submitted for this project.

<u>Reversionary Interest</u>: No determinations of the underlying fee interest of the vacation areas have been made as to title or reversionary interest.

<u>Dedications and Improvements</u>: It will be necessary that the petitioner provides for the dedications and improvements as outlined under Conditions.

<u>Sewers and Storm Drains</u>: There are no existing sewer and storm drain facilities within the areas proposed to be vacated.

<u>Public Utilities</u>: Pacific Bell maintains facilities in the areas proposed to be vacated. Southern California Gas Company did not respond to the Bureau of Engineering's referral letter dated August 28, 2001.

<u>Tract Map</u>: Since the required dedication can be acquired by separate instruments and the necessary improvements can be constructed under separate permit processes, the requirement for the recordation of a new tract map could be waived.

<u>City Department of Transportation</u>: The Department of Transportation states that based on traffic considerations, the vacation is not opposed if a 20-foot wide north-south alley is

constructed connecting 42nd Street to the westerly terminus of the unvacated portion of the east-west alley, together with a corner cut at the northeast corner where the two alleys intersect. In addition, that through the requirements of a tract map or by other means, provisions are made for (1) lot consolidation, (2) driveway and access approval by the Department of Transportation, (3) any additional dedications and improvements necessary to bring all adjacent streets into conformance with the City's Standard Street Dimensions.

<u>City Fire Department</u>: The Fire Department has no objection to this vacation.

Department of City Planning: The Director of Planning, on September 14, 2001, recommended that the vacation be approved.

Summary Vacation: Pursuant to Section 8334(b) of the California Streets and Highways Code, this vacation could be processed under summary vacation proceedings since the vacation areas lie within properties under one ownership and does not continue through such ownership or end touching the property of another.

Conclusion: The vacation of the public alleys (L-shaped) as shown colored blue on the attached Exhibit "A" could be conditionally approved based upon the following:

- 1. They are unnecessary for present or prospective public use.
- 2. They are not needed for vehicular circulation or access.
- 3. They are not needed for nonmotorized transportation purposes.


