To date, over 20 sexual assaults have taken place during the early morning hours that have been linked, either through DNA evidence, or modus operandi to this sexual predator suspect. Los Angeles Police Department detectives have conducted an exhaustive investigation and have been unable to identify the suspect, and believe that no new information will develop without community assistance. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles.
