

ORDINANCE NO. 176300

An ordinance adding Section 61.10 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code and amending Sections 5.502 and 22.356 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to add Bureau of Engineering fees, modify the use of funds under the control of the City Engineer and expand the items for which fees may be collected for the purchase of public records within the Department of Public Works.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Section 61.10 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is added to read:

SEC. 61.10 ENGINEERING PROCESS FEES.

A fee of \$24.00 for each building, plumbing, grading, combined building-mechanical or sign building permit requiring review and sign off(s) by the Bureau of Engineering shall be collected, except that no fee shall be collected if the underlying permit fee is not required. This fee is determined and adopted in the same manner as provided in Section 12.37.I.1 for establishing fees.

Sec. 2. Subsection (h) of Section 5.502 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read:

(h) The City Engineer is authorized to add special projects or special purposes for the use of the money in the Fund.

Sec. 3. Section 22.356 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read:

Sec. 22.356. Public May Purchase Records and Brochures.

The Board of Public Works, upon payment of the fee authorized and required therefore in Section 22.357 of this article, shall furnish to a member of the public, to a representative of a department of the City having control over its own special funds, or of another governmental agency, when acting in his official capacity, microfilm copies of any public maps, plan or record printed copies of standard plans, standard specifications, standard practice instructions, and the City's Bench Mark Index; copies of plans, maps, profiles, charts and specifications reproduced by the following processes: blueprint, negative, brownline, blueline, photostat, electrostat, ozalid, mimeograph, facsimile, cassette diskettes, audio tapes, computerized digital tapes, and any other electronic recordings. If authorized by the Board of Public Works, the Department may also charge a fee for the distribution of specialized guides or


handbooks prepared by the Department. The fees and charges herein shall be determined and adopted in the same manner as provided in Section 12.37-1,1 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code for establishing fees.

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
Sec. 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located in the Main Street lobby to the City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the ground level at the Los Angeles Street entrance to the Los Angeles Police Department; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.

DECLARATION OF POSTING ORDINANCE

I, MARIA C. RICO, state as follows: I am, and was at all times hereinafter mentioned, a resident of the State of California, over the age of eighteen years, and a Deputy City Clerk of the City of Los Angeles, California.
