reports as follows:

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT AND ORDINANCE relative to amending Sections 88.00, 88.07, 88.13, 88.57 and 88.63 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to provide for free parking of certain alternative fuel vehicles.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE amending LAMC Sections 88.00, 88.07, 88.13, 88.57 and 88.63 to:

- a. Establish an hourly rate of \$0.00 (i.e. free) for Alternate Fuel Vehicles properly displaying California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Clean Air Vehicle Decals at all Department of Transportation (DOT) on- and off-street parking meters in the City of Los Angeles until January 1, 2011.
- b. Exempt Alternate Fuel Vehicles properly displaying DMV Clean Air Vehicle Decals from the requirements to deposit coins in parking meters at DOT on- and off-street parking meters in the City of Los Angeles managed by the DOT until January 1, 2011.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

On December 12, 2007, Council requested the City Attorney to prepare and present an Ordinance amending LAMC Sections 88.00, 88.07, 88.13, 88.57 and 88.63 by:

- a. Establishing an hourly rate of \$0.00 (i.e. free) for Alternate Fuel Vehicles properly displaying California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Clean Air Vehicle Decals at all DOT on- and off-street parking meters in the City of Los Angeles until January 1, 2011.
- Exempting Alternate Fuel Vehicles properly displaying DMV Clean Air Vehicle
 Decals from the requirements to deposit coins in parking meters at DOT on- and offstreet parking meters in the City of Los Angeles until January 1, 2011.

Subsequently, on March 18, 2008, your Committee considered January 16, 2008 City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to amending LAMC Sections 88.00, 88.07, 88.13, 88.57 and 88.63 as previously requested by Council on December 12, 2007. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Ordinance to amend the LAMC to provide for free parking of alternative fuel vehicles that are included in the Clean Air Vehicle Decal Program until as late as January 1, 2011.

This matter is now being forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
