Operation YES, the Boyle Heights Chamber of Commerce and the Boyle Heights Neighborhood Council are sponsoring the "Boyle Heights Multicultural Parade & Festival" on October 23, 2005, from 12:00 Noon to 6:00 P.M.

Council District Fourteen has received a request that the City provide certain services and declare this function a Special Event. Approval of this request will mean that an estimated \$5,659 in fees and salary costs will be absorbed by the City. (Event Coordinator: Robert Jimenez -323/270-7346 and Fax No. 323/269-6937).

ITHEREFORE MOVE that the "Boyle Heights Multicultural Parade & Festival" be declared a Special Event, and City departments be requested to waive all fees and costs, except insurance and application requirements.
