LA Sanitation and Environment (LASAN) has identified seven (7) automated decommissioned diesel solid waste trucks and one (1) tractor trailer from LASAN's inventory. LASAN has been transitioning toward a complete phase out of diesel-powered trucks as required by rules enacted by the South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD).

Generally, decommissioned trucks which are in good condition are salvaged and sold in secondary markets. Due to the new Air Quality Management District requirements, salvaged diesel trucks have a very limited market value, as they are not equipped with the alternative fuel engines.

LASAN requests that these surplus vehicles be sold to the City of Ensenada; a coastal city in Mexico, and the third-largest in Baja California.

Last year, on August 25, 2017, a delegation from the City of Ensenada, headed by Mayor Marco A. Novelo Osuna, made an official visit to our City and expressed interest in our decommissioned trucks.

This year, on August 31, 2018, a motion (Martinez - Cedillo) was introduced by City Council in which LASAN is to submit a report to the Board of Public Works for consideration/recommendation of the sale of seven (7) automated diesel solid waste trucks and one (1) tractor trailer at below market value in accordance with LAAC Sec. 22.547 (Donation of Surplus City Equipment to a domestic or foreign government) to the City of Ensenada, Baja California, Mexico, to meet the objectives of mutual cooperation between the Cities. (CF# 05-2349-S1).
