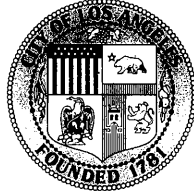




**MOTION**
