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ORDINANCE	NO	
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An ordinance amending Section 8.149.4 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to increase the parking rate for the Convention Center.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 8.149.4 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read:

SEC. 8.149.4. Vehicle Parking Rates.

The vehicle parking rate shall be \$12.00 per vehicle at any vehicle parking lot or facility under the control and management of the Los Angeles Convention Center Department. The General Manager of the Los Angeles Convention Center Department may authorize a vehicle parking rate greater than authorized here to be charged for non-Convention Center event parking or by a licensee whose use of the facility requires exclusive control of all or part of the parking spaces available and does not include the use of the spaces by the general public. Any greater vehicle parking rate shall apply only to the parking spaces in control of the licensee.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
