WHEREAS, Dame Elizabeth Taylor has worked tirelessly for over two decades to raise awareness and funds for HIV/AIDS research, critically-needed support services for people living with HIV/AIDS, prevention services and education for populations most in need; and

WHEREAS, Dame Elizabeth Taylor has demonstrated great humanity and compassion in protecting the human rights and dignity of all people threatened by the HIV/AIDS epidemic; and

WHEREAS, Dame Elizabeth Taylor has been a great supporter of AIDS Healthcare Foundation, the nation's largest provider of HIV/AIDS healthcare, prevention and education and operator of free AIDS clinics in the United States, Africa, Latin America/Caribbean and Asia; and

WHEREAS, Dame Elizabeth Taylor has been a generous donor to the AIDS Healthcare Foundation, most recently to its clinic in Durban, South Africa, the Ithembalabantu ("People's Hope") Clinic; and

WHEREAS, Dame Elizabeth Taylor is a truly dedicated AIDS activist and will be celebrating her 75th birthday on Tuesday, February 27, 2007.
