COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, ENTERTAINMENT AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE, relative to a plan to administer and monitor the Film L.A. contract.

Recommendations for Council action:

- 1. NOTE and FILE the report from the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) dated December 5, 2016 relative to an update on film-related data systems.
- 2. NOTE and FILE the report from the Board of Public Works, Office of Film Television Production dated May 5, 2017 relative to contract administration for Film L.A. Inc. Contract No. C-117026.
- 3. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD), with assistance from City Administrative Officer (CAO), CLA, Film L.A. and the Film L.A. Contract Administrator, to identify requirements for a film-related system that would address LAFD's current needs, including any costs and staffing necessary to develop the new system.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Public Works, Office of Film Television Production. Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

<u>SUMMARY</u>

At the meeting held on May 9, 2017, your Entertainment and Facilities Committee considered CLA and Board of Public Works, Office of Film Television Production reports relative to a plan to administer and monitor the Film L.A. contract, including a standardized reporting tool, metrics and other relevant factors; the performance metrics set forth in the contract and the Contract Administrator's reporting tool; complaints received utilizing the same complaint reporting format used by Film L.A.; and linking Film L.A.'s Online Permitting System with the City's film related information systems. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee Chair moved to approve a recommendation contained in the CLA report dated May 3, 2017, as detailed above and note and file the other reports before the Committee. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
