BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the case entitled Michael Hunt, Matthew Dowd v. City of Los Angeles.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to deposit a total of \$270,000 with the United States District Court in the case entitled Michael Hunt, Matthew Dowd v. City of Los Angeles, United States District Court Case No. CV06-04691 DDP (SSx), from Liability Claims Account No. 9770, Fund 100, Department 59.
2. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw a demand thereon in said amount payable to the United States District Court.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted



SUMMARY

At its meeting of August 3, 2009, the Budget and Finance Committee considered in Open Session a City Attorney report relative to the case entitled Michael Hunt, Matthew Dowd v. City of Los Angeles, United States District Court Case No. CV06-04691 DDP (SSx). This case arises out of constitutional challenges to Los Angeles Municipal Code Sections 42.15 and 63.44. Without discussion, the Committee recommended approval of the City Attorney recommendations. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
