**DRAFT ORDINANCE RENEWING A PRIVATE LINE FRANCHISE TO
CATHOLIC CHARITIES OF LOS ANGELES, INC.**

Honorable Members:

This Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance grants the renewal of an expired private line franchise (Franchise) to Catholic Charities of Los Angeles, Inc. (Franchisee). The Information Technology Agency has already submitted a report to Council regarding this matter.

Background

The draft ordinance permits the Franchisee to continue to maintain one fiber optic conduit measuring 4 inches in diameter and 20 feet in length, in the public right-of-way of the alley connecting two buildings under the control of the Franchisee at 1671 Beverly Boulevard and 1650 Rockwood Street in the City of Los Angeles. The franchise fee to be paid for the ten-year term of this Franchise is \$1,000, in addition to the required performance bond in the amount of \$10,000. The draft ordinance grants the renewal of a private line franchise which expired on June 30, 2017. This Franchise will expire on June 30, 2027.
