

## AUGUST 25, 2007 MUSICIANS INSTITUTE DAY IN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES



WHEREAS, Since opening its doors in 1977, Musicians Institute has primed over 20,000 musicians, producers, engineers, vocalists and industry professionals for successful careers in every genre of contemporary music...
