## RESOLUTION TO VACATE NO. 14-1401087 (California Streets and Highways Code Sections 8324 and 8325)

Vacation of Werdin Place from approximately 173 feet northeasterly of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to its northeasterly terminus.

On October 21, 2008, the City Council considered the evidence submitted regarding said vacation and determined that said alley should be vacated subject to the conditions of vacation having been complied with, (CF 07-3144). All conditions of the Council's action have been fulfilled. No public easements are being reserved from this vacation.



IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED that from and after the recordation of this Resolution, the area described hereinabove is vacated.
