TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to current policies and procedures for the maintenance of the bike/walking path along the Metro Orange Line, specifically between Balboa Boulevard and Hazeltine Avenue.

SUMMARY

On May 7, 2009, the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) submitted a report, in response to Motion (Cardenas - Greuel), that provided background information and a status report on the maintenance of the Orange Line bicycle path. At a regular meeting held on May 27, 2009, the Transportation Committee considered the LADOT report regarding the maintenance of the bike/walking path along the Metro Orange Line, specifically between Balboa Boulevard and Hazeltine Avenue. Representatives from the LADOT and Los Angeles Police Department gave the Committee background information on the matter. An opportunity for public comment was held. Afterwards, the Committee moved to note and file the LADOT report, inasmuch as the report is submitted for information only and no Council action is necessary.
