ORDINANCE	NO.	181227

An ordinance amending Section 12.03 and Subdivision 19 of Subsection A of Section 12.21 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code relating to trash chutes and recycling chutes.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 12.03 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended by adding the definitions of "Recycling Chute" and "Trash Chute" in proper alphabetical order to read:

RECYCLING CHUTE. Any vertical smooth shaft used to convey recyclable materials from the upper floors of a building to a recyclable storage bin or room at the bottom end of the chute.

TRASH CHUTE. Any vertical smooth shaft used to convey rubbish, trash, or garbage from the upper floors of a building to a trash storage bin or room at the bottom end of the chute.

- Sec. 2. The first unnumbered paragraph of Paragraph (c) of Subdivision 19 of Subsection A of Section 12.21 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended to read:
 - (c) Requirements for Recycling Areas or Rooms in a Development Project. All new development projects, all existing multiple-family residential development projects of four or more units where the addition of floor area is 25 percent or more, and all other existing development projects where the addition of floor area is 30 percent or more, shall provide an adequate Recycling Area or Room, as defined in Section 12.03 of this Code, for collection and loading of Recyclable Materials. When a new development project provides a Trash Chute or an existing development project adds a Trash Chute, a Recycling Chute shall also be provided in both cases. Recycling Chutes shall be clearly marked "recycling only" at every point of entry.
- Sec. 3. The first paragraph of Subparagraph (12) of Paragraph (c) of Subdivision 19 of Subsection A of Section 12.21 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended to read:
 - (12) Recycling Areas or Rooms shall be placed alongside of trash areas or rooms wherever possible and shall comply with the following:

Sec. 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.

EXEMPTION, PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT, COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE, COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, AD HOC COMMITTEE ON RECOVERING ENERGY, NATURAL RESOURCES AND ECONOMIC BENEFIT FROM WASTE FOR LOS ANGELES and ORDINANCE relative to amending Sections 12.03 and 12.21 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code relating to trash chutes and recycling chutes.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. FIND that this action is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article II, Section 2(m) of the City's CEQA Guidelines.
- 2. ADOPT the September 26, 2008 FINDINGS of the Director of Planning as the Findings of the Council.
- 3. PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE, approved by the Director of Planning, amending Sections 12.03 and 12.21 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to define trash chutes and recycling chutes; to require recycling chutes when new projects expanding floor area are adding trash chutes; to remove the requirement for separate trash and recycling rooms; and to require proper identification for recycling chutes.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a hearing held on February 3, 2009, the Planning and Land Use Management (PLUM) Committee considered and, after an opportunity for public comment, recommended that Council approve the City Attorney report and Ordinance amending Sections 12.03 and 12.21 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to define trash chutes and recycling chutes; to require recycling chutes when new projects or projects expanding floor area are adding trash chutes; to remove the requirement for separate trash and recycling rooms; and to require proper identification for recycling chutes.

On November 24, 2009 and June 22, 2010, the Chair of the Energy and Environment Committee and Chair of the Ad Hoc Committee on Recovering Energy, Natural Resources and Economic Benefit from Waste for Los Angeles, respectively, concurred with the PLUM Committee recommendation. This matter is now forwarded to Council for its consideration.
