SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on December 12, 2012, the Housing, Community and Economic Development Committee considered Motion (Cárdenas – Smith) relative to requesting the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), in conjunction with the Mayor's Office of Gang Reduction and Youth Development, to report on the current level of coordination between law enforcement and gang intervention workers including: recent efforts that have expanded and improved the overall partnership; lessons learned from working in partnership, and; attempts to have the Los Angeles Board of Police Commissioners incorporate the Community-Based Gang Intervention Model and overall framework into LAPD's policy manual, practices, and training curriculum (Council File No. 08-0615-S3).

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to receive and file the Motion. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
