This Office recommends that discussions with, and advice from, legal counsel regarding the recommendation for City Council action in this pending litigation be scheduled and held in closed session before the Public Safety Committee on January 13, 2012, pursuant to California Government Code Section 54956.9(a). Government Code Section 54956.9(a) requires you to state publicly prior to the closed session, what subdivision of this section authorizes the closed meeting, and that the closed session is being held to confer or discuss with, or receive advice from, legal counsel regarding pending litigation.

The pending litigation includes more than 50 separate lawsuits filed against the City by medical marijuana dispensaries, owners, operators, and patients. The lawsuits challenge the City's medical marijuana ordinance on a wide variety of legal grounds and seek to enjoin enforcement of the City's Ordinance.

We request that this matter be placed on the closed session portion of the Public Safety Committee's agenda of January 13, 2012.
