HUIZAR AMENDMENTS

I THEREFORE MOVE that CF #08-0923, the Proposed Ordinance to establish regulations regarding medical marijuana collectives, be AMENDED to instruct the City Attorney to make the following changes to the ordinance:

- 1) Amendment 1: Place a cap of two per community planning area on the number of collectives. The Los Angeles City Council shall reconsider the cap in the future if it determines that it is too restrictive to meet the needs of qualified patients in Los Angeles.
- 2) Amendment 2: Require each facility to have a 24-hour on-call contact posted at the entrance to each location. Each collective must have a designated person and functioning phone number as the contact.
- 3) Amendment 3: Remove Section 45.19.6.6 (Existing Medical Marijuana Operations) which would result in pre-ICO registered collectives to not be granted legal nonconforming status, nor to continue to operate for 180 days while they come into compliance, nor to be given priority status for relocation.
