The Greater Community Multipurpose Center project in Council District Seven has been designed to be a one-stop community services center and will be programmed to respond to the critical needs of individuals and families of the Pacoima Community. Services will include community sensitive day-care services for families re-entering the workforce, job training programs, college courses with Los Angeles Mission College, and coordinated service programs for local seniors and youth. Many service providers are often dispersed throughout the community, presenting a challenge for community members who rely on public transportation. The Greater Community Multipurpose Center will provide a convenient one-stop destination to access various critical community services.

The Council had previously authorized the use of Council District 7 Street Furniture Revenue Funds for this project (Council File No. 08-1415). Since then, it has been determined that an alternative funding source is more appropriate.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council hereby RESOLVE that \$100,000 in the Lopez Canyon Landfill Community Amenities Trust Fund No. 531-14, Account No. L32, be utilized to fund outstanding expenses for remaining physical improvements to be completed as part of the Multipurpose Center project, in addition to any operational expenses to be incurred as part of the services provided to the Pacoima and Lake View Terrace Communities.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be directed to prepare the necessary document(s) and/or agreement(s) with the Greater Community Missionary Baptist Church, or any other agency or organization, as appropriate, in the above amount, for the purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality, if needed, and that the Councilmember of the District or the City Clerk be authorized individually to execute such agreement of other document(s) on behalf of the City, if needed.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Council action of June 3rd, 2008 relative to allocating Council District Street Furniture Revenue funds for the above purpose (CF 08-1415), BE RESCINDED.
