TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an update on the bicycle sharing program request for information (RFI).

Recommendation for Council action:

DIRECT Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to:

- 1. Initiate discussions with the three most viable respondents to the RFI in order to determine the feasibility of implementing a bicycle sharing program in Los Angeles.
- 2. Work with the Metropolitan Transit Authority (MTA) and their vendor on their bicycle sharing program.
- Report back to the Transportation Committee with a proposal from the recommended vendor for the Committee's review and consideration or a determination that a project of this type is currently infeasible.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The LADOT reports that no fiscal impact is anticipated outside of previously funded staff, which will work to select the contractor and manage the ongoing project operations, if a project is implemented in Los Angeles.

SUMMARY

At a meeting held on January 13, 2010, the Transportation Committee considered the LADOT report regarding an update on the bicycle sharing program request for information. An opportunity for public comment was held. Afterwards, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the LADOT report, but amended the second report recommendation to direct the LADOT to work with the MTA and their vendor on their bicycle sharing program. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
