COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR and MEMBER, TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE relative to the feasibility of creating a bicycle sharing program in the City of Los Angeles.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Greuel - Garcetti - et al):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to report back with a Request for Information on a bicycle sharing program after holding discussions with the bicycle community and the Bicycle Advisory Committee.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis on this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on September 24, 2008, the Transportation Committee considered Motion (Greuel - Garcetti - et al) regarding the feasibility of creating a bicycle sharing program in the City of Los Angeles. An opportunity for public comment was held. A representative from the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) provided the Committee with background information on bicycle sharing programs in other cities and countries. After a discussion, the Committee moved to instruct the LADOT to report back with a Request for Information on a bicycle sharing program after holding discussions with the bicycle community and the Bicycle Advisory Committee. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
