Your **TRANSPORTATION** Committee

report as follows:

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a proposed contract with Veolia Transportation for the DASH Packages One, Two, and Three services.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the General Manager of the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to execute a three year contract with two one-year options with Veolia Transportation for the DASH Packages One, Two, and Three services, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer reports that total compensation for the three-year term will not exceed \$65 million. Funding for the costs occurring this fiscal year is provided in the City's 2009-10 Proposition A Adopted Budget. Funding for future year's operations will be budgeted in future City Proposition A fund budgets, contingent upon available funding. There is no impact to the General Fund.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a meeting held on September 23, 2009, the Transportation Committee considered a proposed contract with Veolia Transportation for the DASH Packages One, Two, and Three services. An opportunity for public comment was held. Afterwards, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Los Angeles Department of Transportation report. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
