COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR and MEMBER, TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE relative to a month-to-month extension of the existing Community DASH Package One, Two, and Three shuttle bus service contracts.

Recommendations for Council action:

- 1. AUTHORIZE the General Manager of the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to amend the existing Community DASH Package One and Two contract with MV Transportation (C-110827) on a month-to-month basis, not to exceed six months, at a rate of \$76.87 per service hour, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the LADOT General Manager to amend the existing Community DASH Package Three contract with Veolia Transportation (C-110399) on a month-to-month basis, not to exceed six months, at a rate of \$86.76 per service hour for the first three months and \$90.66 per service hour for the last three months (if needed), subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The LADOT reports that there is no impact to the budget and that there are sufficient funds included in the City's adopted Fiscal Year 2009-10 Proposition A Budget for the services.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on June 12, 2009, the Transportation Committee considered a month-tomonth extension of the existing Community DASH Package One, Two, and Three shuttle bus service contracts. Representatives from the LADOT gave the Committee background information on the matter. An opportunity for public comment was held. Afterwards, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the LADOT report. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
