COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR AND MEMBER, PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE relative to establishing Valet Parking Operator and Valet Parking Attendant permit requirements.

Recommendation for Council action:

REQUEST that the City Attorney prepare an ordinance amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to establish Valet Parking Operator and Valet Parking Attendant permits requirements and authorizing Bureau of Street Service investigators to cite for violations of the new permit requirements, substantially as written in the draft Ordinance dated March 21, 2013 (attached to the Council file), as modified to require Valet Parking Attendants to wear photo identification cards, and to stipulate that valet parking permits be filed with, and maintained by, the Board of Police Commissioners.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

<u>SUMMARY</u>

Accompanying a report to Council dated March 21, 2013 (attached to the Council file), the City Attorney presents Ordinance amending the LAMC to establish Valet Parking Operator and Valet Parking Attendant permits requirements and related enforcement protocol. The Ordinance was prepared in response to Council action taken December 5, 2012.

At the special Public Safety Committee meeting held March 27, 2013, the Committee Chair and Member discussed this matter with representatives of the Board of Police Commissioners, the City Attorney, and the Los Angeles Department of Transportation. The Committee Chair and Member recommended that Council request that the City Attorney prepare a revised Ordinance, modified to require Valet Parking Attendants to wear photo identification cards, and to stipulate that valet parking permits be filed with, and maintained by, the Board of Police Commissioners.
