EDUCATION AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to eliminating the Neighborhood Councils "rollover" policy and transferring suspended funds totaling \$1.61 million to the Reserve Fund.

Recommendations for Council action; as initiated by Motion (Krekorian – Hahn – et al)

- 1. TRANSFER rollover funds of the Neighborhood Councils to the Unappropriated Balance (UB) account, subject to honoring contracts, committed projects, ongoing rent and leases, and unpaid bills upon providing documentation; and DIRECT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) and Department of Neighborhood Empowerment (DONE) in consultation with the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners (BONC) and Neighborhood Councils (NC), to prepare an implementation plan and report to Education and Neighborhoods Committee in two weeks.
- 2. DIRECT the CAO, CLA, DONE in consultation with the BONC and NCs, to revisit the roll over policy, and to create a process for rolling over funds that would include a verification process by either BONC or the Council and report to Education and Neighborhoods Committee in two weeks.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement:</u> Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

#### SUMMARY

At its special meeting of February 16, 2010, the Education and Neighborhoods Committee considered the Motion (Krekorian – Hahn – et al) relative to eliminating the Neighborhood Council's "rollover" policy and transferring suspended funds totaling \$1.61 million to the Reserve Fund.

After providing the opportunity for public comment, presentations by the affected departments, presentation by Budget LA, and consideration of available information before it the Education and Neighborhoods Committee recommended approval of the recommendations as contained in the recommendation section of this report.
