COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR and MEMBER, BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE relative to a revised Special Events Fee Subsidy Policy Ordinance.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

APPROVE the recommendations contained in the Chief Legislative Analyst's (CLA) report dated August 7, 2009, attached to the Council file, relative to a Revised Special Events Fee Subsidy Policy Ordinance, with the following amendments:

a. Replace CLA Recommendation No. 1C with the following recommendation:

Bureau of Street Services (BOSS) will consider public safety and welfare issues and input from departments and affected Council Office(s). BOSS may issue permit(s) for requested Special Event and include conditions required by Council Offices and departments to maintain public safety and welfare of the community and the City.

b. Hold in abeyance Recommendation No. 5, relative to authorization for one Accounting Clerk II in the Office of the City Clerk for administration of the Special Events Fee Subsidy line item and subaccounts in the GCP, and REFER the matter to the Personnel Committee for its consideration and recommendation.

c. Replace the CLA's list of Citywide Special Events with the revised list attached to this Committee report.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CLA reports that adoption of the recommendations contained in this report will increase the Reserve Fund by a minimum of \$2.5 million annually.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

SUMMARY


At its meeting on August 10, 2009, the Chair and Member of the Budget and Finance Committee considered the CLA's report relative to a revised Special Events Fee Subsidy Policy Ordinance. On June 9 and 16, 2009, the Council considered an ordinance to amend, repeal and adopt various provisions of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to establish a Special Events Permit Procedure and Fee Subsidy Program (C.F. 09-0600-S46). The Council referred this matter to the Budget and Finance Committee for further consideration of various issues. Following numerous meetings between the CLA and the City Attorney to address issues which arose during Council's

consideration of the previous draft Ordinance, the CLA report proposes procedures which will be codified by a revised Ordinance to be prepared by the City Attorney.

During the Committee discussion, the Chair requested that the revised Ordinance include the provision that a non-profit organization with an operating budget of greater than \$5 million would not be eligible for a Special Events Fee subsidy. The Chair asked that this be included in the Ordinance to be consistent with other City fee subsidy policies, i.e., the Convention Center Fee Subsidy Policy and the Development Fee Subsidy Policy. The CLA report includes a list of Citywide Special Events for the Council to approve (CLA recommendation No. 9); however, in Committee the CLA submitted a revised list which the Chair asked to be provided in Council District order; the revised list is attached to this Committee report for the Council's consideration.

The Budget and Finance Committee recommended approval of the CLA report recommendations relative to a revised Special Events Fee Subsidy Policy Ordinance, as amended in Committee and reflected in this Committee report. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.

MOTION

I MOVE THAT THE COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHIEF LEGISLATIVE ANALYST relative to a revised Special Events Fee Subsidy Policy Ordinance, Item No. 3 on today's agenda (C.F. 09-0600-S46) BE AMENDED, as follows:

1. Substitute the attached "Citywide Special Events" list for the attachment to the CLA report which provides for removal of duplicate events and adds several special events which were inadvertently omitted;
2. Rename the line item in the General City Purposes Fund (GCP) "Special Event Fee Subsidy" to "Council Fee Subsidy," to be used to fund subsidies for Special Events, Development Fees, Convention Center Fees, and any other subsidies in accordance with Council adopted Financial Policies. The allocation of budgeted funds in the amount of \$2.5 million will remain, \$1.5 million for Council Districts (\$100,000 per district) and \$1 million for Council-approved Citywide Special Events.
3. Transfer budgeted funds in the amount of \$175,000 in the GCP line item "Special Fund Fee Subsidy" to the Reserve Fund, and eliminate this line item.
4. Amend the Council action of June 16, 2009 (C.F. 09-0600-S46), relative to delaying the effective date of imposing a moratorium on all Special Event declarations for events which take place after August 31, 2009 to September 30, 2009, inasmuch as the Ordinance establishing a Special Events Permit Procedure and Fee Subsidy Program will likely not be effective until that date.

MOTION

I THEREFORE MOVE that CF #09-0600-S46, the proposed Special Events Fee Subsidy Policy, be AMENDED to instruct the CLA and Bureau of Street Service to report back to Council within 30 days with the following information:

* A list of every Certified Farmers' Market in the City and a full accounting of what City staff costs are associated with their operations.

* A report on the feasibility of offering Certified Farmers' Markets a single, annual permit for events that take place on the same time and place each week, rather than issuing separate permits for each week of operation at a cost of \$528 per permit (\$27,456 a year).

* A proposed list, formed with input from all the associated Council offices, of which markets can be treated like a block party where no expenses are charged, and which should qualify as Citywide events, where residents from three or more Council districts attend and up to half the cost can be subsidized.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Attorney be instructed to prepare any revisions to the proposed Special Events Fee Subsidy Policy ordinance that are necessary to allow local Council offices to subsidize the remaining costs for Citywide Farmers' Markets using their local special event fee subsidy funds, similar to current rules for local ones.
