SUBJECT: THE AFFECT OF RENT ADJUSTMENTS ON THE GENERAL FUND

On February 1, 2010, the Budget and Finance Committee (Committee) instructed El Pueblo de Los Angeles Historical Monument (El Pueblo) to report on the affect rent increases will have on the General Fund.

Rent adjustments effective April 1, 2010 increase revenue by \$1.2 million. Including the rent adjustments, total revenue for fiscal year 2010-11 is projected to be \$4.8 million. Furthermore, Common Area Maintenance fees expected to increase on July 1, 2010, will partially offset custodial, security, and building maintenance costs. Successful implementation of rent adjustments results in El Pueblo becoming self-sufficient. As the Department will be self-funded in fiscal year 2010-11, it is not fiscally or operationally prudent to eliminate positions which are not funded by the General Fund.

## Recommendation

To disapprove the City Administrative Officer's recommendation to eliminate 10 positions in El Pueblo's Department Personnel Ordinance.
