

On June 16, 2009 (C.F. 09-0600-S46), the Council considered an Ordinance to amend various sections of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to establish a Special Events Permit Procedure and Fee Subsidy Program, which was referred back to the Budget and Finance Committee for further study and revision to address concerns of various Councilmembers.

Because the Budget and Finance Committee has not received recommended changes to the Ordinance to address Councilmember concerns, and will not likely have an opportunity to agendize this matter until a meeting in August, the current process should be continued through August 31, 2009. This action would continue the Council's policy decision to forestall the effective date of a moratorium on special events fee waivers, approved by the Council in conjunction with the 2009-10 Budget.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council, AMEND the Council action of June 16, 2009 (C.F. 09-0600-S46), relative to delaying the effective date of imposing a moratorium on all Special Event declarations for events which take place after July 31, 2009 to August 31, 2009, inasmuch as the Ordinance establishing a Special Events Permit Procedure and Fee Subsidy Program will not likely be agendized for Council consideration until a meeting in August 2009.
