The Boys & Girls Clubs of the South Bay has requested funding to establish a new community center located at the northern leg of Del Amo Boulevard and Denker Avenue, in the Harbor Gateway. The Cheryl Green Community Center will provide after-school programs to youth ages 6 to 18. To assist with the establishment of the new the center, the Boys & Girls Club will salvaged a 24x60 modular trailer that is being donated to house the community center.

In order to expedite funding for the community center, the Community Development Department (CDD) is requesting authority to transfer \$23,000 in UDAG savings from the Boyle Heights Youth & Technology Center in CD14 to support the establishment of the Cheryl Green Community Center in the Harbor Gateway. The proposed funding will be used to fund after-school youth programs in the Harbor Gateway.

UDAG funding for the Boyle Heights Youth & Technology Center will be replaced by an equal amount of CDBG funding from program savings identified in the Day Laborer CBDO program (Account C309).

I THEREFORE MOVE the General Manager of the Community Development Department (CDD), or his designee be authorized to transfer \$23,000 in UDAG savings form the Boyle Heights Youth & Technology Center in CD14 (Acc No. V802) to the Boys & Girls Clubs of South Bay to establish the Cheryl Green Community Center located at the northern leg of Del Amo Boulevard and Denker Avenue, in the Harbor Gateway.

I FURTHER MOVE that the General Manager of the Community Development Department be authorized to transfer \$23,000 in CDBG savings from the Day Laborer Program (Acc No. C309) to the Boyle Heights Youth & Technology Center and to prepare a minor amendment to the 33rd PY Action Plan, in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan.

I FURTHER MOVE that the General Manager of the Community Development Department, or his designee be instructed to negotiate and execute an Agreement with the Boys & Girls Clubs of the South Bay and amount not to exceed \$ 23,000 to fund youth programs at the Cheryl Green Community Center.

I FURTHER MOVE that the General Manager of the Community Development Department (CDD), or his designee to authorized to prepare necessary Controller Instructions to implement the intent this motion.
