The Community Development Center and Council District 14 are sponsoring the "3rd Annual Boyle Heights Technology Center Community Awards Gala" on May 29, 2009, from 5:00 P.M. to 12:00 A.M.

Council District Fourteen has received a request that the City provide certain services and declare this function a Special Event. Approval of this request will mean that an estimated \$13,322 in fees and salary costs will be absorbed by the City. (Event Coordinator: Jasmine Alvarado - 323/526-0146).

I THEREFORE MOVE that the "3rd Annual Boyle Heights Technology Center Community Awards Gala" be declared a Special Event, and City departments be requested to waive all fees and costs, except insurance and application requirements.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Event Sponsor be directed to fulfill the insurance requirements of the City by contacting the Bureau of Street Services - Street Use Inspection Division at 213/847-6000 to obtain, and complete, the necessary insurance forms, upon adoption of this Motion by the City Council.

I FURTHER MOVE that pursuant to Ordinance No. 150,567 relating to temporary street closures, the following streets be closed on Friday, May 29, 2009 from 8:00 A.M. to Saturday, May 30th at 2:00 A.M., subject to the supervision of the Director of the Bureau of Street Services:

- Eagle Street between 101 Freeway entrance and Gless from Friday, May 29th at 8:00 A.M. to Saturday May 30th at 2:00 A.M.
- Eagle Street between Gless and Clarence from Friday, May 29th at 8:00 A.M. to Saturday May 30th at 2:00 A.M.
- Clarence Street between 6th and 4th Streets from Friday, May 29th at 3:00 P.M. to Saturday, May 30th at 1:00 A.M.


I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Street Services be directed to furnish the necessary traffic control devices. These devices will be provided with the understanding that the sponsoring organization will pick up and return them to the Bureau, and remove any debris following this event.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Transportation be directed to post "Temporary No Stopping" signs and provide traffic control personnel, if necessary.


