TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to traffic management services provided at the Hollywood Bowl, Greek Theater, Dodger Stadium, Staples Center, L.A. Live Complex, and the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum, in and around Exposition Park.

Recommendation for Council action:

NOTE and FILE the Los Angeles Department of Transportation reports dated September 1, 2009 and September 22, 2009, as initiated by Motion (LaBonge - Parks - Perry - Reyes), inasmuch as agreements between the City of Los Angeles and the venues have been reached to reimburse the City for traffic management services provided by the Los Angeles Department of Transportation and no Council action is necessary.

**SUMMARY**

At a regular meeting held on October 14, 2009, the Transportation Committee considered the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) reports dated September 1, 2009 and September 22, 2009, as initiated by Motion (LaBonge - Parks - Perry - Reyes).
