The Los Angeles Police Department and other City departments have been planning for the memorial service to honor the memory and accomplishments of the late entertainer, Michael Jackson, at the Staples Center on Tuesday, July 7th beginning at 10 a.m. Due to his world-wide popularity, the LAPD estimates that this event could draw between 500,000 - 750,000 persons to the area in and around the Staples Center and LA Live. In order to maintain public health and safety, certain services are being provided by City forces.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council instruct the CAO to report back to the Council within 30 days on the services provided by the LAPD, LAFD, DOT, Public Works Bureaus of Sanitation and Street Services, GSD, ITA, Convention Center, and any other department required to provide services necessary to safeguard public health and safety including, but not limited to the following:

- Police protection
- Fire and emergency medical response
- Traffic control
- Trash receptacles
- Portable toilets
- Street cleaning/repairs
- Illegal vending enforcement
- Security
- Communications services

I FURTHER MOVE that the CAO report to the Council on any permits and insurance policies that may have been taken out by the memorial service organizer(s) to limit the City's liability resulting from this event.

I FURTHER MOVE that the CLA be instructed to report to the Council within 30 days on existing policies and procedures by which City services are provided under specific circumstances, and which may, or may not, have been followed in this instance.
