

reports as follows:

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a status update of the Google E-mail and Collaboration System Pilot.

Recommendations for Council action:

- 1. NOTE and FILE the City Administrative Officer (CAO) report dated April 13, 2010, attached to the Council file.
- 2. INSTRUCT the Information Technology Agency (ITA) to provide a status update on the pilot in 30 days.
- 3. INSTRUCT the ITA and appropriate staff to turn off access to the GroupWise system for all City users that have migrated to the Google system, excluding users at the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD).

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on May 4, 2010, the Information Technology and Government Affairs Committee considered a CAO report relative to an update of the Google E-mail and Collaboration System Pilot including the Google Implementation Working Group's action to expand the number of participants and the duration of the pilot project. Representatives of the CAO, ITA, LAPD, Bureau of Engineering, and Los Angeles Fire Department provided a status update of the pilot program and responded to related questions from Committee members. The ITA reports that the Google system is still expected to be fully implemented by June 30, 2010. After further discussion on how the requirement to keep both GroupWise and Google operational has negatively impacted the system, the Committee recommended to note and file the CAO report and add the recommendations detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to Council for its consideration.
