

My name is Erica Broido.

The problem that needs addressing is illegal parking by chronic offenders- in our case two food trucks- but this is not about food trucks per se. Fines enforce parking regulations and enforcement is for deterrence because violations ~~harm~~ harm people, ~~victims~~. The City is currently impotent to stop two food trucks on my street who accept their daily \$73 dollar ticket as a cost of doing business and continue to park there every day, obstructing views of oncoming traffic on a busy street, often used by emergency vehicles .

They have caused accidents...a pregnant woman transported to the hospital, a second car accident, customers crossing the street facing near misses, screeching breaks, residents being literally unable to leave their driveways due to blocked views - all caused by two food truck vendors willful disregard of the law.

As a representative of my neighbors and a board member of the Brentwood Homeowner's Association, I ask you to support Mike Bonin's motion to study the ONLY tools for the City to stop the violators who ignore the City's laws and create dangerous conditions.
