Pursuant to your request, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance amends Subdivision (b)2.F of Section 80.73 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to establish escalating penalties for each 30-minute increment during which a catering truck remains in violation of the time permitted to vend in Section 80.73(b)2.F in a residential area. The draft ordinance also adds a new Subsection (h) to include a severability clause.
