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PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the SB 165 report for the Proposition Q - Citywide Public Safety General Obligation Bond for Fiscal Year (FY) 2013-14.

NOTE and FILE the City Administrative Officer (CAO) report dated June 30, 2016, attached to the Council file, relative to the SB 165 report for the Proposition Q - Citywide Public Safety General Obligation Bond for FY 2013-14.

## SUMMARY

At the meeting held on June 30, 2016, your Public Safety Committee considered a CAO report relative to the SB 165 report for the Proposition Q - Citywide Public Safety General Obligation Bond for FY 2013-14. The CAO reports that under California Government Code Section 53411, enacted as part of the Local Agency Special Tax and Bond Accountability Act of 2000 (SB 165), which applies to any local bond measure placed on the ballot on or after January 1, 2001, the chief fiscal officer of the issuing agency is required to file an annual report with its governing body concerning the use of local bond measure proceeds. Section 53411 requires the annual report to include: a) the amount of funds collected and expended; and, b) the status of any project required or authorized to be funded as identified in the statement indicating the specific purposes of the bond authorization. At this time, the requirements of SB 165 apply only to Proposition Q -Citywide Public Safety General Obligation Bond, which was approved by the voters in March, 2002; and, to Proposition O - Clean Water, Ocean, River, Beach, Bay Storm Water Cleanup Measure General Obligation Bond approved by the voters in November, 2004. After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee recommended that Council note and file the SB 165 report for the Proposition Q - Citywide Public Safety General Obligation Bond for FY 2013-14, inasmuch as the report is submitted for information only and no further Council action is necessary. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
