Months following the untimely passing of the world renown entertainer, Michael Jackson, and the subsequent memorial service held in his honor at the Staples Center, there continues to be disagreement regarding the actual cost of City services to support the memorial service, authority to mobilize such resources and whether such costs are a City responsibility or if a private party should be held responsible to reimburse the City for all, or a portion, of such costs. Accordingly, there is an urgent need for clarification of the policies and process by which the City deploys resources for extraordinary events so that the issue of responsibility for reimbursement of City costs incurred in support of the Michael Jackson Memorial Service can be resolved.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council instruct the City Administrative Officer and the Chief Legislative Analyst to include in the joint report in response to Motions (Perry - Parks) C.F. 09-1678, (Hahn - LaBonge) C.F. 09-1716, and (Zine - Perry) C.F. 09-1715, relative to various aspects of deployment of City resources in support of the Michael Jackson Memorial Service, a discussion of the policy and process by which resources are deployed for extraordinary events by the Los Angeles Police Department, Los Angeles Fire Department, Emergency Management Department, Department of Public Works - Bureaus of Street Services and Bureau of Sanitation, Recreation and Parks, Transportation and others.


