On March 3, 2010, the Palms Neighborhood Council (PNC), at their General Board Meeting, passed a Motion recommending that the City of Los Angeles enact an Ordinance regarding wireless telecommunications facilities in the City. As written in the Minutes of that Meeting:

“MOTION (by Dee Olomajeye, seconded by John Riordan): The Board of Palms NC respectfully recommends that with the City Attorney’s guidance and consistent with his recommendations, the City enact a comprehensive new ordinance with clear and consistent standards and procedures regulating all wireless telecommunications facilities in the City, authorizing regulation of aesthetics and providing protection to communities and residential neighborhoods to the full extent of the law.

MOTION PASSED unanimously by a voice vote.”
