TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE relative to a speed limit revision for Riverside Drive between Vineland Avenue and Van Nuys Boulevard.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. APPROVE the amendment of Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 80.81 to revise the recommended speed limit for Riverside Drive between Vineland Avenue and Van Nuys Boulevard from 35 to 40 miles per hour, so as to be able to retain radar enforcement.
- 2. PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying Ordinance amending LAMC Section 80.81 to establish the recommended speed limits of Recommendation No. One and amend the Ordinance to reflect the revised boundaries.
- 3. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to report back in 90 days on the impact of the new speed limits.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Transportation Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on February 24, 2010, the Transportation Committee considered the Board of Transportation Commissioner (Board) report regarding a speed limit revision for Riverside Drive between Vineland Avenue and Van Nuys Boulevard. An opportunity for public comment was held. Afterwards, the Committee moved to revise the boundaries, approve the recommendations contained in the Board report, and direct the LADOT to report back on the impact of the new speed limits. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
