TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE relative to speed limit revisions for Beverly Glen Boulevard between Ventura Boulevard and Mulholland Drive.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- CONCUR with the Board of Transportation Commissioners (Board) action of August 13, 2009 approving the amendment of Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 80.81 to revise the recommended speed limit for Beverly Glen Boulevard between Ventura Boulevard and Mulholland Drive as follows:
 - a. Beverly Glen Boulevard between Ventura Boulevard and the northerly intersection of Valley Vista Boulevard from 25 to 30 miles per hour.
 - b. Beverly Glen Boulevard between the northerly intersection of Knobhill Drive and Sumac Drive from 35 to 30 miles per hour.
- 2. PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying Ordinance amending LAMC Section 80.81 to establish the recommended speed limits of Recommendation No. One.
