PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the payment of a reward for information leading to the arrest and subsequent indictment of the person responsible for the shooting deaths of Khachik Safaryan and Lusine Safaryan on December 11, 2008 and Karine Hakobyan on March 26, 2010.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. APPROVE payment to the claimant of a reward offer in the total amounts of:
  - a. \$75,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person responsible for the deaths of Khachik Safaryan and Lusine Safaryan on December 11, 2008 under Council file No. 09-0010-S9.
  - \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person responsible for the death of Karine Hakobyan on March 26, 2010 under Council file No. 10-0010-\$20.
- 2. INSTRUCT the City Clerk to:
  - a. Transfer, in total, \$125,000 from the Reserve Fund to the Unappropriated Balance and APPROPRIATE therefrom to the Special Reward Trust Fund No. 436/14.
  - b. Transfer, in total, \$125,000 from the Special Reward Trust Fund No. 436/14, Account No. XXXXXX to the Police Department Fund No. 100/70, Secret Service Account No. 004310.
- 3. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to make the appropriate reward payments.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

## Summary:

At a special meeting held on August 22, 2018, the Public Safety Committee considered a Board of Police Commissioners report regarding reward payment for various murders. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended on consent to approve the recommendations from the Board and the reward payment.
