

The Street Furniture Revenue Fund provides funds for transit related projects, sidewalk projects, curb / sidewalk improvements, beautification projects needed to improve conditions for public transit patrons, and all expenses relating or incidental thereto, as well as on general services to the community in each Council District.

The Eagle Rock Association (TERA) has donated the completed Eagle Rock Monument at Wiota Circle to the City of Los Angeles and the residents of Eagle Rock. However, financial assistance is required to light the monument during the evening hours. Once this financial provision is made, the Monument will serve as a beacon to Eagle Rock residents and visitors alike, welcoming them to our treasured community for many years to come.

This effort is of special benefit for the residents of the City and for CD-14 and deserves financial assistance from the City.

Sufficient funds are available in the Street Furniture Revenue Fund which could allocated for this purpose.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$900 in the Council District 14 portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund No. 43D Dept. 50 be transferred/appropriated/allocated to pay for the Department of Water and Power (DWP) electrical service for the nighttime lighting of the Eagle Rock Monument at Wiota Circle located at 5110 Wiota Street, Eagle Rock, California 90065 for a period of two years. (The relevant DWP numbers are as follows: Account No. 1-62-92159-05110-00-0000-0-01, Work Request No. 908702, Service No. P34125, Meter No. FM9-1233318).

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Street Services be directed to prepare the necessary document(s) with, and/or payment(s) to DWP and/or The Eagle Rock Association and/or any other agency, entity or payee, as appropriate, in the above amount, from the above source, and for the above purpose.

I FURTHER MOVE that Bureau of Street Services be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarification as necessary to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
