On December 28, 2009, the Zoning Administrator of the Office of Zoning Administration of the Los Angeles Department of City Planning (ZA), issued a determination finding that "the operation of the liquor store known as the Liquor Bank... is a public nuisance." To "mitigate the adverse impact [the Liquor Bank] has on persons and properties in the surrounding area," the ZA imposed 28 operating conditions.

The real property owner, and the business owner/operator for the Liquor Bank, have each filed their own appeal from the above determination. Both appeals will be decided by the City Council, after a public hearing at the Planning and Land Use Management (PLUM) Committee, on the dates and times set forth above.

As the communications secretary for the Cherrywood/Leimert Block Club (CLBC), which has approximately 100 dues-paying members, and encompasses all of Leimert Park, I am writing to

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inform you that the CLBC *fully supports all of the conditions* imposed in the above determination, against both the real property owner, as well as the business owner/operator. The CLBC's position was determined by *unanimous* vote of our members during our regularly scheduled monthly meeting, held February 20, 2010, with approximately 50 persons in attendance. The basis of our position is that the conditions are necessary to mitigate the continuing detrimental effect the operation of the Liquor Bank has on our community and its residents.

Accordingly, the CLBC respectfully requests that you vote to fully support all of the conditions imposed, and to deny each appeal in its entirety.
