

Electra Drive between Mt. Olympus Drive and Hercules Drive of Council District 4 is a residential street that also serves as a feeder street to Laurel Canyon Boulevard and the Hollywood district for residents of the Mt. Olympus area. The street is on a steep slope and residents state that cars travel at excessive speeds which result in a public safety hazard. For the past three years, the Mt. Olympus Property Owners Association has contacted the City to install street safety measures such as speed humps and speed feedback signs, but no improvements have been made.

The City discontinued its speed hump program in the 2009/2010 budget as a result of funding constraints. Given the City's current fiscal environment, the Mt. Olympus Property Owners Association has offered to pay all costs associated with the safety improvements that meet the City's criteria.

**I THEREFORE MOVE** that the Department of Transportation be instructed to report relative to the feasibility and the necessary requirements to allow private funding to be used to contract the installation of speed humps and solar powered speed feedback signs on Electra Drive, between Mt. Olympus Drive and Hercules Drive, in the Mt. Olympus area of Council District 4.
