ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a proposed agreement amendment with Open Access Technology International (OATI) for energy scheduling, energy trading, and management tools.

Recommendation for Council action:

CONCUR with the Board of Water and Power Commissioner's action of December 1, 2015, Resolution No. 016-113, authorizing Amendment No. Five to Agreement No. 47443 with OATI to extend the contract term by seven years, from a term of 10 years to 17 years, and increase the expenditure authority by \$8.3 million, from an expenditure authority of \$8.1 million to \$16.4 million, for the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) to continue service subscriptions in support of energy scheduling, energy trading, and transmission management tools.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that approval of the proposed agreement will increase the expenditure authority by \$8.3 million, from an expenditure authority of \$8.1 million to \$16.4 million, from the LADWP Power Revenue Fund. There is no impact to the City General Fund. The amendment is consistent with the LADWP adopted Financial Policies.
