PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to status of the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) processing of DNA evidence kits.

## SUMMARY

In various report to the Board of Police Commissioners (attached to the Council file), LAPD provides progress and status updates of the Department's reduction of the backlog of Sexual Assault Evidence Kits. The Department reports also provide responses to recommendations made by Controller audits. LAPD has eliminated the historical backlog of evidence kits and continues to refine its work process. It is LAPD's goal to ensure the timely testing of all evidence kits and to reduce the reliance on the outsourcing of DNA analysis.

At its meeting held January 11, 2013, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council note and file LAPD's report. The Committee commended LAPD for the progress it has made eliminating the evidence kit backlog and for the timely testing of all incoming evidence kits.
