Dear Mr. White,


I'm writing to you to express my objection to CF 10-0982 and have also written to Councilman Paul Koretz who is my Councilman to the same effect.

Passage of this measure would inflict more noise pollution and sanitation problems from irresponsible owners of which we already have more than enough.

I find it hard to understand why Councilman Koretz is supporting this kind of measure. His office staff has given me a list of cities which claim to have no problems with multiple of dogs per household, yet comparing Los Angeles with Oahu, Hawaii, or Denver, Colorado, doesn't change the fact that barking dogs next door to you or to the Councilman will keep you up at night, and having 5 of them will make it 5 times worse. (What's happening in Oahu or Denver is then completely irrelevant to our city.) My hope for the Councilman when he was elected to the 5th District was that he would turn his attention to our existing problems which are quite pressing and negatively impacting our quality of life, such as: gridlock on our streets with traffic backup up for blocks, and a crying need for parking structures on 3rd Street. Instead, we are looking at an additional burden of having multiple dogs messing up our easements and streets, and THIS he is supporting. One can only surmise that no dogs live in our Councilman's immediate street.
